NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES CLOSE at 6:00 PM, Wednesday, Oct.14, 2020 after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. **SEND ENTRIES WITH FEES TO Laura Trainor, 144 West Hill Rd., Vestal, NY 13850. MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO SNKC** (add \$5 for international money orders). No overnights entries requiring signature will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES: \$30 for 1st Obedience entry, \$26 for 2nd Obedience entry of same dog, same day. Rally \$30 first entry \$26 second entry, and \$22. third class.

50¢ recording fee for the first entry and \$3.00 event service fee for both entries.

ALL Obedience and Rally Classes will be judged by jump height. Make sure your dog's jump height is on the entry. **Classes will all be judged tall to small each day.**

A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. Obedience/Rally trial or Tracking test. This fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one Obedience class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

TELEPHONE ENTRIES, UNSIGNED ENTRIES, and ENTRIES WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted. **ENTRIES NOT ON AN OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM or PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS WITHOUT THE AGREEMENT** on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY shall be made or accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Bank service fee will apply to any returned checks.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Entry fees will be refunded minus a \$5/ day processing fee for bitches in season. Notification must be made to the Secretary by 12 noon on the day of the trial with a veterinary certificate.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM Dogs will not be permitted in the building until just prior to their class being judged. Please refer to detailed instructions which will be sent in the Entry Conformation document. Dogs not required for further judging are excused.

AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB CERTIFICATION Permission has been given by the American Kennel Club for the holding of this event under American Kennel **JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT** for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The trial-giving club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system, stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to crates except when being judged.

EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOGS at show site and motels.

THE TRIAL COMMITTEE/SECRETARY will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of, any accident or misfortune to dogs or exhibitors participating in this trial.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event. **EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIANS' RECOMMENDATIONS** to assure that their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. New York State law requires that dogs aged four months and older be vaccinated against rabies.

MOVE-UPS to a higher class are permitted as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations **RALLY JUMP HEIGHTS** (Advanced, Excellent, Masters): Height at withers under 10 inches: jump height 4 inches. Height at withers 10 inches to under 15 inches: jump height 8 inches. Height at withers 15 inches to under 20 inches: jump height 12 inches. Height at withers 20 inches and over: jump height 16 inches. **Rally Ring** will be 40'x50'

ALL Obedience and Rally Classes will be judged by jump height. Make sure your dog's jump height is on the entry. All days will be judged tall to small. Judging will be indoors.

Entry Fees -\$30.00 for 1st Obedience entry, \$26 for 2nd Obedience entry of same dog, same day. (Includes \$.50 AKC recording fee for the 1st entry and \$3.00 Event Service fee for both entries.)

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-given club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4.A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog had been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
