The Club will also offer Rosettes for new titles – please alert the Secretary if you expect to complete a title at this event.

These will be CONCURRENT Tests using a BLOCK SCHEDULE.

NO RUN ORDER will be mailed out, a time block will be assigned.

ROLL CALL

Events will run <u>concurrently</u> with rolling check-in and inspection. Plan to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your scheduled run block. This is a "show & go" event, we ask that you depart the site when you have completed all your runs unless you are available to assist other entrants.

Every dog must pass through inspection before <u>each</u> run. Dogs who have not been inspected for *each* run will not be run. If you do not check in by the start of the last run block, we will assume you are absent.

No refunds for ABSENT DOGS. At inspection, all dogs will be examined for fitness to run. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test. Please contact the Test Secretary if your bitch comes in season prior to the event.

<u>At inspection</u>, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded, less any processing/convenience fees.

Early acceptance of dogs for members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to published test hours.

Hours

Grounds will be available one hour prior to event hours.

Event hours are from 8:00AM until all runs are completed.

It is the responsibility of each entrant to be ready with catcher and releaser when their dog is called to the line.

What is the Fast CAT?

- 1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
- 2. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.
- 3. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH). MPH is calculated by

204.545 divided by the run time (204.545/x=MPH)

- 4. Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied and points are earned:
 - 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
 - Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

5. FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

6. Titles are earned at specific point levels

BCAT = 150 points, DCAT = 500 points, FCAT = 1,000 points FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

*ACCORDING TO AKC RULES:

- Handlers in FastCAT are not permitted to <u>travel</u> down the 100-yard course <u>during</u>
 a dog's run or just prior to a dog being released for its run.
- It is recommended that an owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed. A handler cannot recall their dog from the start line.
- Dogs that are physically challenged due to loss of limbs are eligible to enter...For safety purposes, any dog requiring an assistance apparatus, such as a wheeled cart will not be allowed to participate.
- Dogs with artificial coloring in their coats may participate in FastCAT. The coloring must not cover more than one-third of the dog's coat. The coloring must not disperse (leave a cloud) when the dog is running...
- Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything
 other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including
 whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or food or toys including the waving of objects to
 lure the dog to the finish line. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name only.
- Head halters, such as the Gentle Leader or Halti, may be used on the grounds but
 must not be worn while running the course. Dogs may be muzzled at the
 owner's discretion...Special Training devices that are used to control and train
 dogs, including but not limited to, collars with prongs, electronic training
 devices may not be used on dogs at AKC events.

In the event the fun runs are not held/completed based on the Club's decision, fun run fees will be refunded in full. There are NO refunds for missed fun runs; you may sell/give away your **fun run**.

Test Information

- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- The show grounds may not be completely fenced. The CAT course will be fenced.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- On site bathroom facilities are available.
- The Hunt master is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. He/She has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs (determined unfit at inspection) will be excused and their entry fees will be refunded less a \$3.50 processing fee
 - . No refunds for absent dogs.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC / sponsoring Club(s) / dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the event site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason
 of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act
 of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond
 the control of the Club.
