INTRODUCTION TO FARM DOG CERTIFICATION

The Susque-Nango Kennel Club will be offering an introduction to Farm Dog Certification event on Sunday March 9 in Windsor NY - the site of the planned Farm Dog Certification tests on Saturday March 15, 2025

WHO: Dog handler teams with basic obedience skills are encouraged to pursue the Farm Dog Certified Test title. No herding or contact with livestock is required – dogs show the skills involved in being responsible visitors in a farm setting.

WHAT: We will review the Farm Dog Certification requirements, which build on basic CGC skills, and provide an opportunity for handler/dogs to try the various elements – such as walking by farm animals and equipment, walking on different surfaces, jumping on a hay bale, properly walking through gates, etc. For a description of all the farm dog certification requirements see https://www.akc.org/sports/herding/farm-dog-certified-test/

WHEN/WHERE: These overviews will be offered on Sunday March 9 at Sugar Bush Gap farm, 283 Williams Rd., Windsor NY. The event will be largely under cover in case of unfavorable weather. The event will start at 1 p.m. Please register in advance.

COST: The cost for the event is \$10 – or the reduced cost of \$5 for SNKC working members and current SNKC class participants.

FARM DOG CERTIFIED TEST: Enter the March 15 Farm Dog Certified Test – forms available at www.snkc.org and at the Introduction event. Entries close on March 12 or when limits are reached.

NOTE: Please be sure that all participating dogs are up to date on vaccinations against communicable diseases!

DIRECTIONS FROM SYRACUSE, ITHACA, WESTERN NY:

<u>From the North and West</u>, take Interstate 81 South or Rt 17 east. Take EXIT 2 on I81 South to go Rt 17 east (the normal interchange is closed for construction). Take EXIT 77 toward WEST WINDSOR. Turn RIGHT onto PLACE Rd. At the top of the hill, turn SLIGHT LEFT onto TRIM ST. Go 4.2 miles and Turn RIGHT onto WILLIAMS RD. Proceed to 283 Williams Road (0.9 miles)
