

**EXHIBITOR INFORMATION**

- All dogs nine (9) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration are eligible to participate.
- Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are lame, blind, or deaf or have open sores shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is bandaged, stitched or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes. If course conditions warrant, protective footwear may be worn if approved by the Judge.
- At the handler's option dogs may wear flat buckle collars, snap collars, or slip collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. No harnesses or coats are allowed for the test. Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Prong and electric collars (live or dummy) are prohibited on the grounds. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area.
- You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care. It is expressly understood that every dog at this test/trial is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises. Susque-Nango Kennel Club is not responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause.
- To prepare for this test, familiarize yourself with the 12 required elements found in the Farm Dog Certified (FDC) Test Regulations. *Farm Dog Certification and AKC Herding Regulations* are available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606-3390 or online at <https://www.akc.org/sports/herding/farm-dog-certified-test/>. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with the rules and regulations.

**FARM DOG TEST GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION AND ENTRY FEES**

**ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED TO 25 DOGS per test, day of entries will be limited to availability**

**Entry Fees: \$30.00 per entry** (includes \$4.50 AKC recording fee). Make all checks and money orders payable to **Susque-Nango Kennel Club or SNKC**. No Entries shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Day of entry is \$30.

Post-Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to each returned check.

Exhibitors are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing of entries.

Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished upon request.

**A \$5.00 processing fee per dog will be deducted for ANY refunds.**

Declining Entries: **Susque-Nango Kennel Club** may decline any entries or may remove any dog from its event for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with American Kennel Club.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all elements safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the test site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Susque-Nango Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Susque-Nango Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Susque-Nango Kennel Club or any official thereof.

### REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition may apply for a refund with a letter from a veterinarian.

**Bitches in season are not allowed on the test property.** Refunds will be given for the full entry fee with proper notification. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first test of the day of the trial.

### TEST AREA

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to locate dogs that are not brought into the test area when required.

**EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN:** At check-in you will receive your armband number.

**Exhibitors MUST check-in for EACH test they have entered.**

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.
